Kline Organic Produce is excited to be offering a subscription for produce. Take a minute to find out more about our CSA!

How does it work?

As a member of our Community Supported Agriculture program (CSA), you would pay a set advance fee in exchange for a specific number of boxes of produce for a specific amount of time. Your produce box will contain a variety of the produce we grow seasonally, including some items we don't take to farmer's markets. We also hope to include recipes and farm news about events and specials.

Why would I want to subscribe?

We enjoy eating from our garden throughout the year, and we think our customers enjoy doing the same. As a CSA member, you'd receive a convenient, steady supply of fresh, seasonal produce; and by subscribing, you'd support local farmers and the production of quality, organically grown food.

How would I get my produce?

We will concentrate on delivering produce to a few central drop points on **Tuesdays or Thursday (in Oakdale only)**, and you would be responsible for picking up your produce on delivery day. We currently have two locations secured in Modesto:

Concetta restaurant located downtown at **1205 J St.** The location is very central to many parts of downtown and there is usually parking available either along J St. or 11th. or 12th. Due to the hours at the restaurant, pick-up times are limited from noon - 3 PM or after 5 PM.

Remax Executive Office is located at **3425 Coffee Rd.** just south of Sylvan.

Our third location is the option of picking up your box at our house in Waterford.

A fourth location has been added in Oakdale - pick up at the Oakdale Certified Farmer's Market on Thursday evenings.

Will there be other pick-up locations?

We need about ten boxes per delivery location to warrant a separate drop point. E-mail Brian@klineorganicproduce.com with your ideas!

When would I start to pick up my produce?

Our goal is to start delivery May 12th.

How much does it cost?

Please see our [CSA form](#) for prices. By paying in advance, you are sharing the costs of farming with us. In essence, you are farming with your dollars, letting us turn your dollars into great produce! What happens in the garden is reflected in your box--so the selections will change naturally as the season progresses.

Additionally, while we only grow a small amount of certified organic fruit, we are pleased to offer incredibly great tasting, high-quality, non-sprayed fruit from Tyson Hill Farm in Waterford. A fruit portion may be added to your delivery. This year, we are also offering organic eggs with every other week delivery, which can be added to your subscription.
